I hope ACI can attract many more strong women in the future so that our family can continue to grow

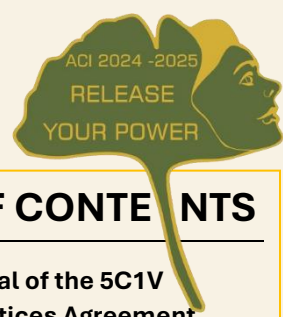

Here's to continued cooperation, friendship, and shared purpose!

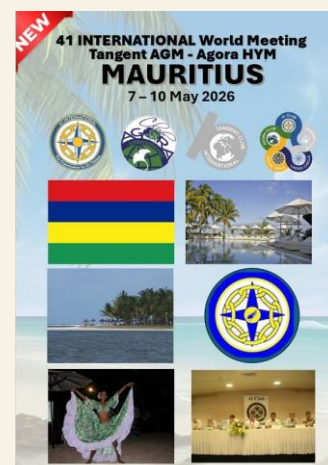

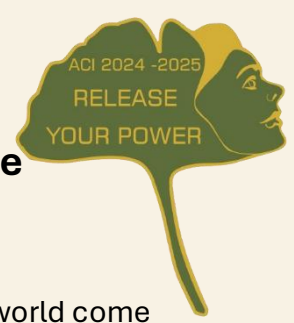

## A Shared Vision: RT Family's Collaboration Fuels ACI's initiative "Laptops4Hope"

Ladies, have you ever wondered what happens when women from different parts of the world come together with a shared goal? Well, here's a heartwarming story that proves how teamwork and a little bit of tech can change lives!

Imagine a young girl in a rural school, looking at a computer for the first time, and saying, "Thank you for believing in our potential." That's the magic of "Laptops4Hope: e-Learning, Evolution" — an inspiring project launched in 2023, with the simple but powerful aim of giving every child the chance to learn through internet and technology, no matter where they come from.

### What is Laptops4Hope?

Laptops4Hope is dedicated to equipping children and teachers in underprivileged areas with essential digital resources. . The project collects donated laptops, repairs them to work well, and sets up small computer labs in schools that face big challenges. For schools without electricity, ACI even funds solar power systems and internet connection so devices can be charged and used effectively.

### The Role of RT Family Members

Members of the Round Table Family are at the forefront of this cause. Agora clubs and other RT Family members from Austria, Belgium, France, Germany, Luxembourg, Madagascar, India, the USA, and Romania have collectively contributed laptops and helped us with logistics. Their collaboration has already made an impact, successfully delivering laptops to schools in Romania, Morocco, Zambia, Zimbabwe, Madagascar, and India bridging gaps that hinder educational progress for the good of the communities.

### Success Stories from Africa

Our friends from **Agora Club Zambia** implemented the first fully equipped IT lab in St Patrick community school in February. The school's opening was praised by the Ministry of Education, especially since it coincided with curriculum changes to promote digital learning.

The Second IT lab was implemented in April in Early Dove Community school. This is a school built by the community and the teachers are paid by the government. They face many problems with lack of resources of all kind so ACI input was very appreciated.

Both schools received 4kw solar power systems to provide electricity during the school time.

Our Zambian Convenor, Matilda, coordinated everything, making sure the locations were perfect and even inviting national TV to broadcast the inauguration. These projects don't just bring computers; they bring hope and opportunity.

**In Zimbabwe**, laptops arrived thanks to members who traveled from the ACI AGM in Hannover and volunteers who visited in April. The laptops were installed at Rafiky Girls School in Harare, a place that supports girls and young women facing family issues, homelessness, or rejection by society. The school provides shelter, education up to the 8th grade, and training in textiles, hairdressing, and beauty. For this school our Zimbabwe Agora Convenor Chido Musasiwa as representative of one of the smallest but powerful Agora associated member, applied to receive 2000 euro from ACI ISP but organized also different very creative fund raising actions and collected a similar amount so installed a full solar power system on the roof, donated furniture and 11 laptops for the newly IT lab. Those young women have now a chance to learn new skills and dream bigger.



**In Madagascar** the project was already implemented in a school where the Agora Madagascar ladies collected themselves locally 5 laptops, refurbished them and donated to **CEG MANANDRIANA** school for the usage of teachers and students.

## **Volunteer Support and Travel Experiences**

Volunteers who traveled to help with these implementations were warm welcomed by our members from Agora clubs. Our friends hosted us and shared their culture, delicious food, hospitality and traditions. Their friendship and commitment supported us when we were in trouble, from our lost luggage in the airport and tire flat in the middle of the dark night to our health issues everything was secured by them. During our trips, we visited famous sites like Victoria Falls, where we saw a rare Moonlight Rainbow, Mukuni traditional village, enjoyed safaris and boat rides on the Zambezi River and Lake Kariba and Imire Rhino wildlife conservancy in Zimbabwe.

## **Upcoming Projects**

**AC India**, a young but very active club collected themselves some laptops and also will receive some financial, logistic and some laptops as well to implement an IT lab in Gautam Buddh Nagar, Uttar Pradesh – in collaboration with Foster and Forge Foundation, in Primary school Baraula school 1, Birsach, for students grade 3 to 5.

Next implementation will take place in **Romania** and is a #side-by-side project Agora e-club together with 41 Club Campulung, to install an IT lab in Primary school Furnicosi, Arges in June 2025.

The second donation in **Madagascar** will take place on the occasion of travels to ACI AGM in South Africa when volunteers can stop in Madagascar for 10 days to carry some more devices for another school next to Antananarivo, than enjoy the experience to visit some natural reserves with lemurs and baobabs

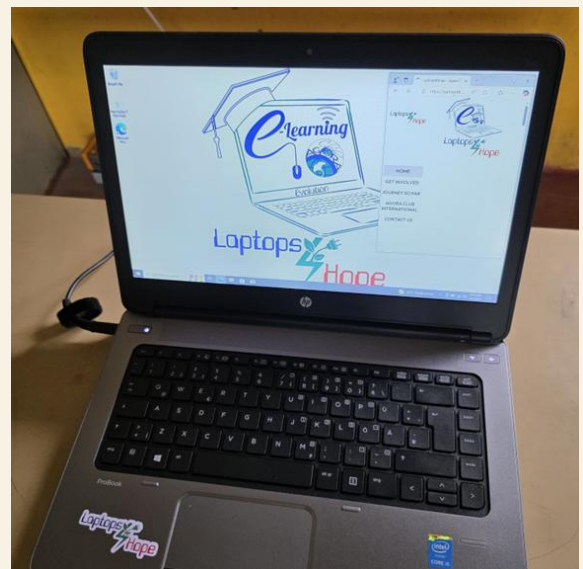

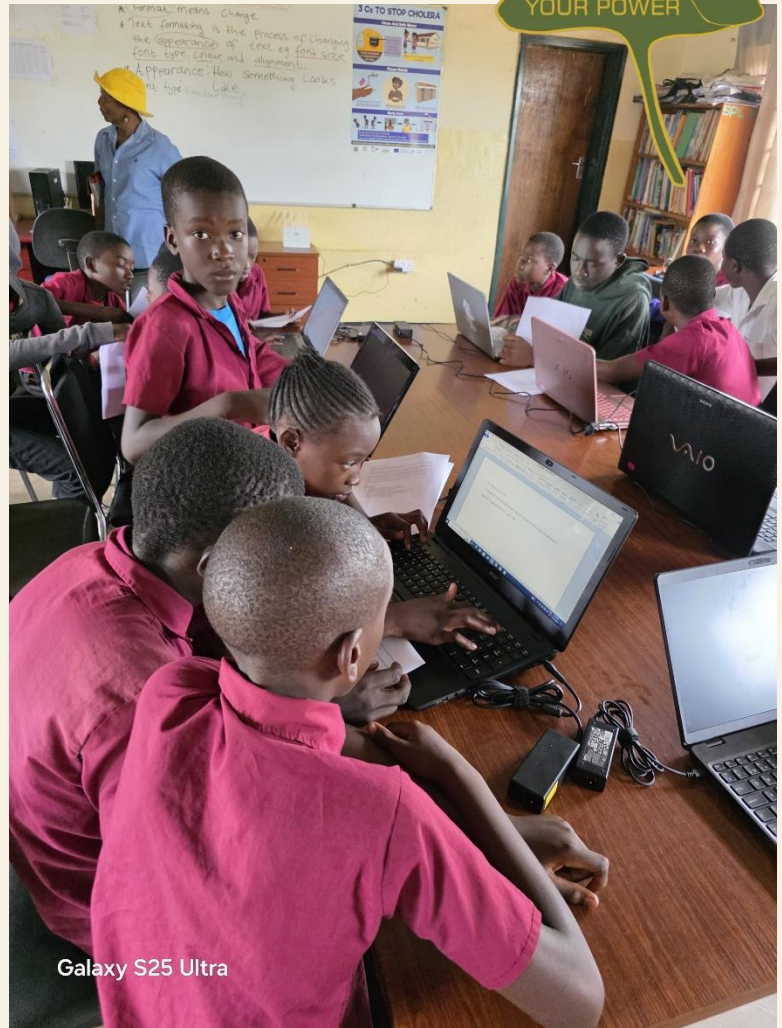

As we wandered around the narrow streets, hearing the bugles and drums in the background was a true experience to be sought. The rehearsal for the Good Friday procession was another highlight of the walk. Every corner revealed a new layer of history, ancient gates, weathered buildings and statues.

Our guide, an International Tourist Institute student and Arts Teacher, Roberta Briffa's research explored the stories of four remarkable women from early modern Birgu. From witches to nuns, her study aimed to give voice to the overlooked female figures in Birgu's rich history. Roberta was dressed in period costume to give the feeling of the era she wished to depict.

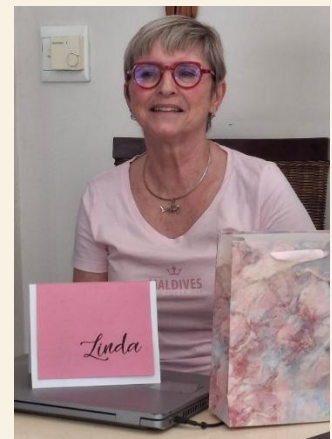
### #ReleaseYourPower: Linda Frew's Story of Strength and Survival

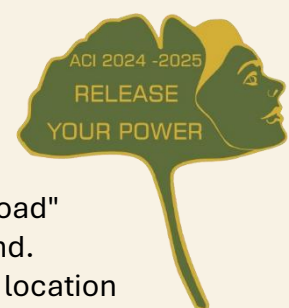

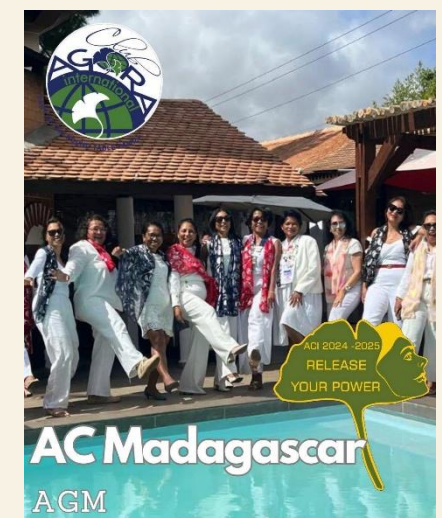

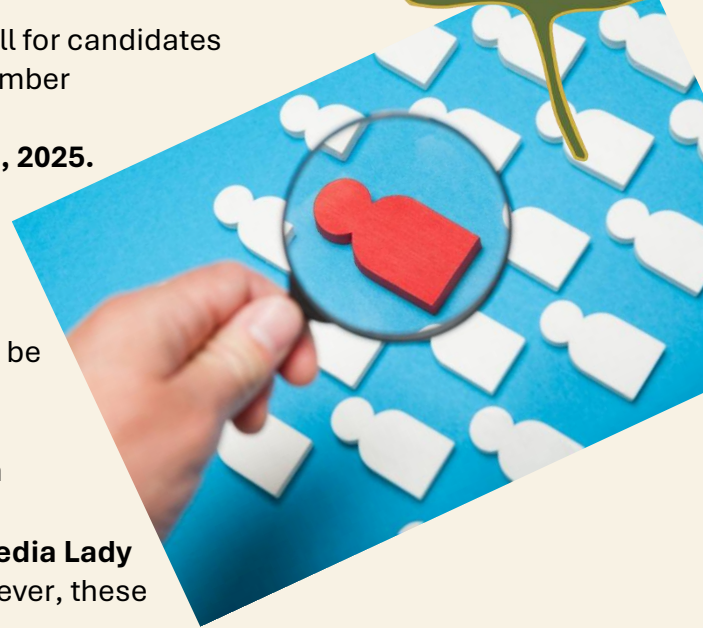
