#### Transport - Travelling to Southend-on-Sea

- By Road
- From the North via A1, M11, M25 & A127 (M25 Junction 29 20 miles)
- From the South via M25, Dartford Tunnel, A13 (M25 Junction 30 25 miles
- By Rail
- Two direct rail lines operate between London and Southend-on-Sea. The journey time on both lines is approximately 45 minutes to 1 hour.
- Southend Victoria (Liverpool Street line) operated by National Express
- Southend Central (Fenchurch Street line) operated by C2C
- By Air
   London Southend Airport 2 miles from centre of Southend (5 mins drive) and 18 miles from Junction 29 of the M25
- London Stansted approx. 40 miles by road
- London City Airport approx. 35 miles by road
- London Gatwick Airport approx. 59 miles by road
- London Heathrow Airport approx. 78 miles by road


